An Act to amend Act 21 of 1836. Preamble. Whereas it is expedient to amend Act 21 of 1836; It is enacted as follows

**1. Lieutenant-Governor may alter limits of existing zilas :-**

It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor <sup>1</sup>\* \* \* \* from time to time to alter the limits of existing zilas in any part of the <sup>2</sup>[States] <sup>3</sup> [to which this Act extends]
