## **ADVOCATES (REMOVAL OF DIFFICULTIES) ORDER, 1966**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section.59 of the Advocates Act, 1961 (25 of 1961), the Government hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

### **1. Short title and commencement :-**

(1) This Order may be called Advocates (Removal of Difficulties) Order, 1966 .

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of November, 1965.

### **2. Extension of term of office of elected members of State Bar Councils required to retire under Sec. 8 of the Advocates Act, 1961 :-**

Every elected member of a State Bar Council due to retire after the 1st day of November, 1965 under Section 8 of the said Act on the expiration of the second year from the date of such reconstitution shall, notwithstanding such expiration, continue to hold office for a further period of one year with effect from the date of such retirement.
