PREAMBLE

An Act to amend certain enactments for the purpose of charging the expenditure referred to therein on the Consolidated Fund of the State.

1. Short title, extent and Commencement :-

(1) This Act may be called the Madras Consolidated Fund (Charged Expenditure) Act, 1950.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Madras.

(3) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st April 1950.
