In view of the intervening developments and the subsequent action taken by the State, as is so stated, the present petition has become infructuous, as

As such, we permit the instant petitioner as also the learned Amicus Curiae to continue to assist on this issue in the said petition.

The instant petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
